MYCETOMA

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Introduction

- Mycetomas ('fungal tumours')
- Caused by a range of fungi or by the procaryotic actinomycetes
- Chronic subcutaneous infection (a type of granulomatous infection)
- Characterized by a triad of S/C swelling, discharging sinuses and discharge containing granules

PATHOGENESIS

- Route of entry of organism-Through minor cut or trauma
- S/C swelling which enlarges and burrows in to deeper tissues to produce characteristic abcess
- Abcess bursts with the formation of multiple sinuses discharging pus containing granules

By examination of granules
