Dear Friends & Colleagues,

It gives me an immense pleasure to announce that the National Symposium on "Optimizing animal reproduction through recent techniques of biotechnology, nutraceuticals and alternative medicine" and XXXVII Annual Convention of ISSAR will be organised at the Department of Veterinary Gynaecology & Obstetrics, College of Veterinary Science & Animal Husbandry, Nanaji Deshmukh Veterinary Science University, Jabalpur, Madhya Pradesh during 16-18 November, 2022.

Reproduction is a back bone of animal production which needs to be optimized time to time for sustainability of livestock industry. In this regard many things has been devised and introduced newer techniques in recent past with their own merits and demerits. However, still there is a scope to review the approaches for management of animal reproduction as per demand in this era.

Alternative medicinal approaches supported with nutraceuticals have been practiced in India since time immemorial for treating various ailments in humans and animals alike. According to the World Health Organization, at least 80% of the people in developing countries depend largely on these indigenous practices for the control and treatment of various ailments that affect livestock. Since, India has rich biodiversity of medicinal plants and traditional knowledge on herbal medicines to treat the animals and human beings, Central Council for Research in Ayurvedic Sciences in the Ministry of AYUSH, Government of India, New Delhi was established. Recently, a Global Centre for use of traditional medicine has also been established in cooperation with WHO in India to promote traditional medicine. Many of these ethno-veterinary practices offer viable alternatives or complements to conventional & western style veterinary medicine especially where the latter is unavailable or inappropriate. Moreover, NDDDB is promoting the use of Ayurvedic Veterinary Medicines for more than 20 ailments and has brought out brochures and video clips on preparation and application of these formulations in all the major vernacular languages in the country so as to reach the farmers and departments concerned with Animal Husbandry in the country. However, with recent advanced in assisted reproductive technologies like IVF, embryo-transfer, embryo sexing & transgenesis, a new era has emerged in reproductive biology.

The present National Symposium has been planned to provide a common platform for the academicians, researchers, professionals and policy planners as well as field veterinarians to brainstorm and provide guidelines on issues for optimizing the reproductive efficiency of animals for sustainable production.

We cordially invite you to this symposium and look forward for your active participation in the scientific deliberations on this auspicious event at Jabalpur.

#### Venue of Symposium

The host institute is College of Veterinary Science & Animal Husbandry, NDVSU, Jabalpur, (Madhya Pradesh). The year 2022 is being celebrated as Platinum jubilee year of the College.

Jabalpur city, named after its founder Rishi "Jabali" and the titled as "Sanskardhani" by Acharya Vinoba Bhave, is situated near virgin river Narmada and provides an unique opportunity for tourists being closer to important National Parks of Madhya Pradesh (Kanha, 167 km; Bandhavgadh, 170 km; Mogli Pench, 160 km; Panna, 200 km), Khajuraho (270 km), Sharda Mata Temple, Maihar (160 km) and places of historical importance that include the Marble Rocks, Dhuandhar Waterfalls, Bhedaghat, Madan Mahal Fort, Gwarighat, Balancing Rock and Kachnar City Shiv Temple. #### Weather and Accommodation
