- 2. Applicants for the post of Assistant Professor and equivalent must not have exceeded the age of 38 years on the first day of January next, provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed by the screening and selection committee, if the applicant is otherwise suitably experienced.
- 3. The upper age limit shall be relaxable upto a maximum of 5 years in the case of candidate belongs to Scheduled Castes, Schedule Tribes and Other Backward Classes.
- 4. <u>Disqualification for appointment of Assistant Professor and posts equivalent</u> <u>thereto</u>:-

(a) Any attempt on the part of a candidate to obtain support for his candidature by any means may be held by the Appointing Authority to disqualify him for appearing in the examination, interview or selection.
